## GLASS & CARAFES

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### CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

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G 125ml C 375ml

**NV Classic Reserve, Hattingley Valley** *England* 13

*The most highly-decorated winery in the country is our pick for the pure Chardonnay position, and it is a devastatingly impressive wine. Choose this sparkler as a pure aperitif or as a thrilling accompaniment to our seafood and fish dishes.*

**NV Piper-Heidsieck, Cuvée Brut, Champagne, France** 15

*Piper's delicious Cuvée Brut is based on a core of Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier and this gives it a mid-palate succulence that is truly mesmerising. Chardonnay is merely used to bring tension and freshness to the finish, making this the perfect Champagne for pairing with our finely spiced dishes.*

**NV Piper-Heidsieck, Rosé Sauvage, Brut Rosé** *Champagne, France* 20

*'Sauvage' translates temptingly into 'wild' and it is wild strawberry and raspberry notes that lead the way here. There is enough depth of fruit and length of the palate to tackle even the richest of our grills and biryanis.*

### ROSÉ WINE

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**2023 Il Rosé di Casanova, La Spinetta** *Tuscany, Italy* 9 28

*While La Spinetta's spiritual home is Piemonte, their Tuscan outpost draws on Provence for inspiration in this 50% Sangiovese, 50% Prugnolo Gentile rosé. The herb notes, pomegranate and cherry themes adore our recipes, making it a Tamarind dream.*

**2022 Susana Balbo, Signature Malbec Rosé** *Mendoza, Argentina* 12 33

*Susana is a longstanding friend of Tamarind, and this rosé is more robust than the others enabling it to romance some of our most flavoursome dishes while retaining an ability to refresh and cool the palate. It is an outstanding choice for adventurous wine lovers.*

**2023 Château Saint Baillon, Rosé** *Côtes de Provence, France* 13 36

*Our favourite Provence rosé exhibits crisp, keen, notes throughout and while moments of pomegranate and melon fleetingly appear, the underlying message is of a resolute, sophisticated creature with a haunting red cherry-scented perfume.*

**2023 Château D'Esclans, Rock Angel Rosé** *Côtes de Provence, France* 17 49

*'Rock Angel is not a turbocharged version of the world-famous Whispering Angel but a rosé more clearly related to the elite portfolio of estate wines from Château d'Esclans. With a hint of oak and the highest quality fruit imaginable, it is seamless, indulgent, and impressively long.'*

**2023 Care, Garnacha Blanca, Nativa** Cariñena, Spain 9 25

*The high-altitude vineyards in Cariñena have a marked impact on the vivacity of this wine, bringing a mineral tang to the lightly stone-fruit-kissed nuances, which refresh the palate beautifully.*

**2024 Ken Forrester, Reserve Chenin Blanc** Stellenbosch, South Africa 11 30

*Ken's nickname in the Cape is Mr Chenin. His talent with this grape is sensational and this Reserve Chenin Blanc is lip-smackingly delicious with green apple freshness and a tang of lemongrass on the finish. It is sheer heaven and the value afforded here is remarkable.*

**2022 Silver Lining, Sauvignon Blanc** Adelaide Hills, South Australia 12 35

*Made by expert vigneron Marty Edwards in the idyllic, high-altitude Adelaide Hills region, looking down on the city below, this is a cool, racy, energetic Sauvignon with a dangerously delicious outlook.*

**2022 Gewürztraminer, Franz Haas** Alto Adige, Italy 14 41

*Gewürztraminer is the most expressive of all white grapes, and Haas' version is jaw-droppingly beautiful. With rose-petal and exotic fruit aromas, a cool, silky texture and a crystalline finish, this wine is sheer heaven.*

**2023 Rosa Ruiz, Albariño, Rías Baixas,** Galicia, Spain 15 42

*Spain's greatest white grape, Albariño, possesses a mildly exotic and enticing perfume while packing a punch of lip-smacking sea spray and citrus on the palate. This counterpoint between lushness and brittle acidity makes it a stunning wine with Indian seafood dishes.*

**2023 Crystallum, The Agnes Chardonnay** Western Cape, South Africa 16 48

*Winemaker Peter-Allan Finlayson is a phenomenal talent, and The Agnes, named after his Great Grandmother, puts oceans of Burgundies to shame with its succulent fruit balanced with invigorating acidity. Chablis lovers need look no further.*

**2023 Sancerre, L'indiscrete, Anthony Girard** Loire Valley, France 19 56

*Sancerre is home to some of the world's most elite and enjoyable Sauvignon Blancs. Girard's old vines, planted on limestone and flint soils make spine-tinglingly engaging wines with firm citrus themes and electrifying acidity.*

**2022 Puligny-Montrachet, Domaine Alain Chavy** Burgundy, France 31 86

*Chavy's stunning Chardonnays, from the most famous village in the world for this regal white grape, are always a joy and in the spectacular 2021 vintage, they are lush, regal, all-pervading and memorable as this wine will attest.*

**2017 Riesling, Cuvée Frédéric Emile, Trimbach** Alsace, France 32 88

*One of the most famous and age-worthy dry Rieslings on the planet, CFE is a glorious treat and simply thrilling with our cuisine. With as much depth of flavour as red wine, this is a sophisticated number with bracing minerality underpinning the exuberance.*

**2020 Anima Umbra Rosso, Arnaldo Caprai Umbria, Italy** 9 26

*Made from the famous Sangiovese grape, most famous for making Chianti, this beauty captures the wild hedgerow fruit notes of the dramatic Umbrian countryside without loading too much weight or tannin on the palate. It is a wonderfully welcoming red.*

**2022 El Tiempo, Que Nos Une Monastrell, Bodega Cerrón Jumilla, Spain** 10 29

*This charming Monastrell loads blackberry and liquorice flavours onto the palate, and while the sensations are resonant and rewarding, this is not a 'heavy' wine. Instead, it packs in juiciness and texture without muscle or brawn, making it instantly enjoyable.*

**2022 Fleurie, Poncié, Pierre-Marie Chermette Beaujolais, France** 12 35

*Elite Beaujolais is one of the most iconic styles of wine to pair with stunning Indian cuisine. Poncié comes from a cool spot in Fleurie and the flavours are pure silk with raspberry, plum and rose petal notes coupled with a bracing snap of acidity on the finish.*

**2019 Valpolicella, Acinatico Ripasso, Accordini, Organic Veneto, Italy** 14 41

*Ripasso-style Valpolicellas have an extra dimension of flavour in the centre of the palate, and this boost of red cherry fruit gives this wine the vitality needed to cut through our raft of sumptuous chicken, duck, steak and full-flavoured vegetable dishes.*

**2021 Teusner, The Riebke, Shiraz Barossa Valley, South Australia** 15 44

*Made from ancient vines by the mercurial Kym Teusner, this award-winning Shiraz shows discreet opulence coupled with an exquisite 'sense of place' and it builds this hauntingly delicious wine from fruit grown by the sixth-generation Riebke family.*

**2022 Ata Rangī, Crimson Pinot Noir Martinborough, New Zealand** 17 49

*Ata Rangī sits atop the New Zealand Pinot ladder, and Crimson is their forward-drinking, silky-smooth number, blessed with black cherry and mulberry tones and remarkable silkiness. The perfume alone will make your pulse race!*

**2022 J'Noon, Cabernet Blend Mahārāshtra, India** 20 58

*J'Noon is a French take on the Urdu word 'Junoon', which means 'passion', and this wine is the passion project of Jean-Charles Boisset and Kapil Sekhri. India's finest take on the Bordeaux blend has resulted in a deep, blackcurrant-imbued wine with terrific class.*

**2019 Château Montgrand-Milon, Pauillac Bordeaux, France** 27 80

*Pauillac is home to some of the exclusive and expensive Châteaux found in our Fine Wine Cellar, so it is unusual to come across such a wine in our by-the-glass collection! Suffice to say, it has all of the cassis and cinnamon hallmarks of this renowned commune.*

**2020 Barolo, Via Nuova, Chiara Boschis, E Pira & Figli Piedmont, Italy** 39 115

*Perhaps serious wine lovers will think that serving a Barolo, by the glass, with complex Indian cuisine is a fruitless task, but no. Chiara's wines are layered, sybaritic, delectable and rewarding, none more so than the Via Nuova Cru with its generosity of Nebbiolo fruit.*
