It is a pleasure to welcome Jacquart one of the world's favourite Champagnes, to our collection. Delicious as an aperitif, talented with a wide variety of starters and deep enough for lighter main courses, too, you will find every occasion to order a glass!

NV Jacquart, Signature Rosé, Champagne, France 22

While La Spinetta's spiritual home is Piemonte, their Tuscan outpost draws on Provence for inspiration in this 50% Sangiovese, 50% Prugnolo Gentile rosé. The herb notes, pomegranate and cherry themes adore our recipes, making it a Tamarind dream.

2025 Catena, Rosé de la Provincia Mendoza, Argentina 12 33

From one of Argentina's most celebrated wine families, this vibrant rosé offers fresh red fruit, floral notes and a crisp finish. Its lively character pairs beautifully with richly spiced dishes, refreshing the palate with every sip. A delightful choice for lovers of expressive, food-friendly rosé.

2025 Château Saint Baillon, Rosé Côtes de Provence, France 13 36

Our favourite Provence rosé exhibits crisp, keen, notes throughout and while moments of pomegranate and melon fleetingly appear, the underlying message is of a resolute, sophisticated creature with a haunting red cherry-scented perfume.

2022 Anima Umbra Rosso, Arnaldo Caprai Umbria, Italy 9 26

Made from the famous Sangiovese grape, most famous for making Chianti, this beauty captures the wild hedgerow fruit notes of the dramatic Umbrian countryside without loading too much weight or tannin on the palate. It is a wonderfully welcoming red.

2023 Fleurie La Bonne Dame , Louis Tête Beaujolais, France 12 35

Elite Beaujolais is one of the most iconic styles of wine to pair with stunning Indian cuisine, comes from a cool spot in Fleurie and the flavours are pure silk with raspberry, plum and rose petal notes coupled with a bracing snap of acidity on the finish.

2021 Valpolicella, Ripasso Organic, Accordini, Veneto, Italy 14 41

Ripasso-style Valpolicellas have an extra dimension of flavour in the centre of the palate, and this boost of red cherry fruit gives this wine the vitality needed to cut through our raft of sumptuous chicken, duck, steak and full-flavoured vegetable dishes.

2021 Teusner, The Riebke, Shiraz Barossa Valley, South Australia 15 44

Made from ancient vines by the mercurial Kym Teusner, this award-winning Shiraz shows discreet opulence coupled with an exquisite 'sense of place' and it builds this hauntingly delicious wine from fruit grown by the sixth-generation Riebke family.

2024 Ata Rangi, Crimson Pinot Noir Martinborough, New Zealand 17 50

Ata Rangi sits atop the New Zealand Pinot ladder, and Crimson is their forward-drinking, silky-smooth number, blessed with black cherry and mulberry tones and remarkable silkiness. The perfume alone will make your pulse race!

2024 Catena, Vista Flores Malbec Mendoza, Argentina 18 54

From high- altitude vineyards in Vista Flores , this Malbec shows the Catena's family's precision and respect for terroir. Silky and vibrant, it offers ripe dark fruit, floral hints, and fine tannins with fresh, elegant finish

2019 Duchesse de Pauillac , Horeau Beylot Bordeaux, France 27 80

Pauillac is home to some of the exclusive and expensive Châteaux found in our Fine Wine Cellar, so it is unusual to come across such a wine in our by-the-glass collection! Suffice to say, it has all of the cassis and cinnamon hallmarks of this renowned commune.

2019 Barolo , Palazzo Schiavino di Cantina Massara, Piemonte Piedmont, Italy 33 96

Perhaps serious wine lovers will think that serving a Barolo, by the glass, with complex Indian cuisine is a fruitless task, but no. The Palazzo Schiavino, with its elegant structure and silky tannins, achieves a beautiful harmony, offering layers of perfumed fruit that complement rather than compete with the spices."
